COURS EPPLICABILITY IRVACERTIFACTION

Only credits that apply tow ard completion of the student's degree program can be certified for VA purposes. Ex.: If 12 credit hours are certified, all 12 must apply. If a student enrolls for 12 credits but only 9 satisfy degree requirements, only 9 credits will be certified. There are two exceptions to the rule.

- f The last semester before graduation, all credit hour staken can be certified if one or more of the credits satisfy a graduation requirement. Last means last. There is only one last semester.
- f If a substitution is requested and approved for a degree requirement, VA will allow the substitution.

REPETINGCOURSES

- f Courses that refailed or for which the grade does not meet minimum requirements for graduation may be certified for VA purposes if they are repeated.
- f Coursesthat are successfull completed may not be certified for VApurposes if they are repeated. If students choose to take additional courses to raise their GPA to graduate, the courses must not have already been successfull completed and can only be taken during the last semester.
